Season Format

Each child will be assigned to a team. Mite teams will be made up entirely of 2015-born skaters, and Jr. IP teams will be made up entirely of 2014-born skaters. There will be no formal evaluations for Mite and Jr. IP. Teams are simply used to distribute uniforms and for splitting skaters up for drills.

The Mite and Jr. IP programs will be delivered by Mike Cormier, with the assistance of parent volunteer On-Ice Helpers. All those on the ice will be certified using the OMHA criteria.

Blue pucks will be used for all Mite and Jr. IP activities. All scrimmages/games played will be cross-ice, as per OMHA and Hockey Canada requirements.



Bond Hours

You are required to complete a minimum of 1 bond job per child registered with DMHA, to a maximum of 2 bond jobs. To sign up for bond positions, please refer to the DMHA website – BONDS/VOLUNTEERS Bond positions specific to the Mite and Jr. IP programs may become available throughout the season, and will be emailed out. The On-Ice Helper position, Program Coordinator position, and Uniform/Name Bar Assistants count for one bond job.

Name Bars

You will have the opportunity to order a name bar for the back of your child's jersey. We will be taking orders and payment for name bars during uniform pick-up. The cost is \$12.

Yellow Tickets

During registration, you paid \$100 for our yellow ticket. Lottery fundraiser. Yellow tickets will be during uniform pick-up.

You can sell these tickets (keep the money you make) or fill them out yourself. Completed tickets need to be dropped into the black drop box between the two rinks (hanging on the mural wall by the doors to the South rink, beside the schedule TV). The first draw is Nov 1st. Please submit your tickets before that date.

Special Events

All Mite and Jr. IP players are invited to skate during the first intermission of the Knights game on Friday, January 24, 2020 (7:30pm). Tickets will be required to the game and a block of tickets will be available for DMHA families. More details to follow.

Uniforms

Children will be required to have the full equipment including a mouth guard. Names should be labelled on helmets and sticks. Helmet names should be visible for the coaches to easily address your child by name. Jerseys and socks are provided by the DMHA. Uniform pick-up will take place on Wednesday, September 18th, 6:00pm-7:00pm, Wednesday, September 25th, 6:00pm-7:00pm, Saturday, September 28th, 7:30am-9:00am and Sunday, September 29th, 7:30am-8:00am. Make sure your child has the proper size stick. Please also ensure that your child's equipment fits properly.

Respect In Sport

One parent for each skater must complete the Respect In Sport module online. More information can be found on the DMHA website here: http://dorchesterdragons.ca/Pages/3670/Respect_in_Sport/. The RIS must be completed before November 1st. You do not need to notify us once you have completed the RIS course. You do not have to do the RIS course again if you have already completed it. The cost of this module is \$12 + HST.
